PREP: Print page 2 on green construction paper.

Print Bows (pages 3—6) on white paper.

Give one wreath and a bow to each student. Based on their bow, they finish the problems on their wreath. First in pencil and then with a sharpie.

On the bow, you can have them write a George Washington / Winter themed multiplication problem using one of their factors. Color in the bow with a red crayon.

Students cut out the wreath. Then, they cut the bow. Glue the bow to the bottom of the wreath.

Add red puffs (dollar store) onto the wreath as cherries, hang wreath.
